The guest speaker for the August 9 meeting will be **Nick Wegner**, Fisheries Biologist, Southwest Fisheries Science Center in La Jolla. Nick is one of the researchers working on rockfish release techniques and survival of released Rockfish. He plans to speak on overall marine sport fishing in southern California ocean waters, with a special emphasis on proper release techniques of under-size and unwanted Rockfish. He will also discuss the current research showing the high survival rate of properly released Rockfish.

### SEPTEMBER SPEAKER



The September 13th meeting guest speaker will be **Bill Varney**, a renown author and lecturer on Surf Fishing in California. Bill resides in Los Alamitos, CA and lectures and holds seminars on Surf Fishing techniques up and down the Southern California coast. He will speak on surf fishing reports, how to read beach and surf conditions, tackle tips, demonstrate field tested surf tackle and how to incorporate natural baits for successful fishing. 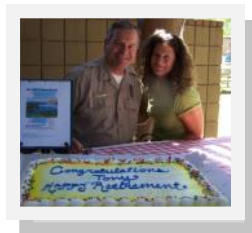
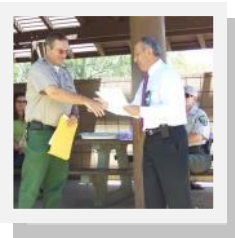
## SUMMER PICNIC-A HUGE SUCCESS
