### Catfish/Carp Dough Bait Recipe

**2 Cups of Instant Oatmeal**

**2 Cups of water**

Mix and let sit until most of the water is absorbed by the Oatmeal, let sit overnight. Luke-warm water will absorb much quicker. (couple of hours)

**ADD:**

**½ cup of Creamy Peanut Butter (for softer bait add 2/3 cup)**

**1 Teaspoon of Garlic Powder (more may work better)**

**2 Tablespoons of Peanut Oil (any oil will work)**

Mix the above ingredients into the oatmeal very well, then stir in 4 cups of flour. Knead the mixture until the dough is very smooth. This may take 5 minutes or more. It will not stick to your hands at this point. You may need to add more flour to get the right consistency. After it sets awhile the dough will become elastic.

Store the dough in the refrigerator in bag or container. It can also be stored in the freezer.

When fishing, it is not necessary to keep cold. Just keep out of the sun. Place back in the refrigerator when you get home. The dough will keep for a week or more.

After baiting the hook, you can dip on extra garlic powder, spread on some 'Doc's Chicken Blood for Catfish' or more peanut butter.
