Fish and Game Report

1. The Commission voted to increase the length to retain sand bass and kelp bass to 14" with a total bag limit of five fish. This needs to go through a legal process and will become effective around March 2013.
2. The Commission voted to increase the number of Boccaccio to three fish per person per day.
3. The PFMC (Pacific Fisheries Management Council) agreed to move forward with developing a formula to give credit for the use of descending devices on cow cod. This is quite important and something we have all worked hard to achieve. It is extremely important we have descending devices in use on the boat to reduce the mortality on rock-fish. Once we have obtained this credit the next step will be to request we get to fish back out to 60 fathoms.




