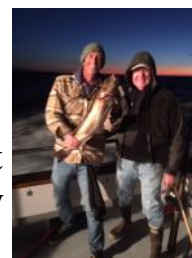

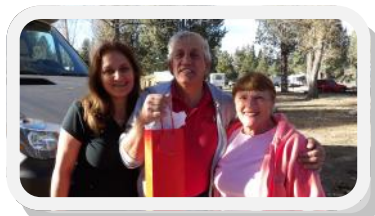
This promises to be a fun program, so plan on attending.

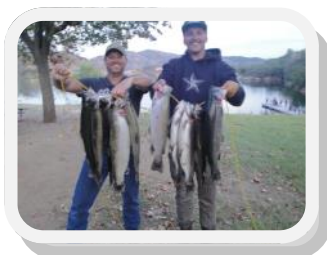
