

SURF FISHING SCHEDULE

Don Continelli has planned the following:

February 19th, 2013 10 AM to 2PM,

South Ponto State Beach, between Life Guard Towers #22 and #23. Directions: I5 to Pointsettia, west to Coast Highway, left to South Ponto State Beach.

Tackle: Medium to heavy spinning rod & reel, 6' plus, 8 to 15lb test line. Bait: Plastic sandcrabs & blood worms, live blood worms (Pacific Bait & Tackle, Oceanside) and anchovies.

Extras: chair, snacks & drink, tackle, rag, shovel and pole holder.

NOTE: Don will provide some instruction for setting up tackle on this date.

March 26, 2013 8AM to 1:PM

Oceanside Harbor Pier. Directions: I5 to Harbor Drive, Oceanside, west to marina are and following N. Harbor Drive to the right to small fishing pier.

LOCAL FISHING

The local lakes Dixon and Wohlford are continuing to provide nice size tailwalkers. Best baits are mouse tails at Wohlford. At both lakes leading baits for trout have been Power bait in rainbow, green and orange does very well. Green, red and orange color Power worms have been the lucky colors for big trout.

The top lures are Kastmasters, Thomas Buoyants, and Rooster tail lures. Night crawlers are the good go-to bait when the bite slows down. 2-4 lb. line is really best when these fish are being finicky.

The next plants will be **February 13 and 27** at both lakes. Mark your calendars and have your excuses for "honey do's" laid out in advance.

NORTH TO ALASKA From Gerry Graff

I have two Alaska trips scheduled for next summer:

Sitka is June 22nd to 28th (king salmon season). Fishing for five days. The lodge charges us \$3350 for everything, food, fishing, lodging, fish packing. Your only additional expense is airfare, tips, and booze. Food is great, fishing has always been excellent. Fishing is four to a boat (one boat fishes five). Mike and Stacey are terrific hosts. The lodge holds 14. I get a half price trip so that gets divvied up among all who come.

Ketchikan trip 2013 (silver salmon season)- Travel to Ketchikan on August 11th (Sunday), fish for 5 days and return on August 17th. Tony has a 6-pack so that's all we can take on that trip. Tony asks for a \$550 deposit now, the rest when we are there. We will stay at a spare apartment that Tony owns and will share the cost of \$250 per night total. We stayed there before and it is quite comfortable. There is no discounted trip for me to share on this one so we all pay the same price, \$275 per day for fishing. We pay the fish processing place separately. It's sort of an a la carte trip so we can only estimate total cost which should be around \$2600 or so.

On either trip, you can fish for fewer days if you like.
