elcome to 2011. We will be focusing on records. Largest fish records that is. Thanks to our Historian Bill Borst, we have a list of the largest fish recorded by specie. It is reprinted in this newsletter. Because it hasn't been emphasized, many of the records for largest fish date back to the 1980s. Keep a copy of these records and when you catch a fish that is larger than the posted, submit a form to the appropriate Vice President and be recognized. If you catch a fish of a specie not listed, submit that fish on the form also. To verify the catch, it must be weighed and signed off by another person. If you are planning on using your own scale to weigh the fish as you might in a Class 2 catch, bring the scale to a meeting or fresh water outing and compare it with our club scale.

Those people who break a record or establish a new record will be recognized at a general meeting. If you are on a club sponsored salt water trip with the Rancho Bernardo Club, our Escondido Anglers should weigh fish just between ourselves, to find out who had the largest fish and if there were any record fish by specie caught.

We are set up to have an excellent year this year. Most of the "Old Guard" have stayed on to do another year on the Board. I certainly have appreciated this. Three new faces to the Board are: Bob Hughes – Program, Jim Walker – Raffle, and Will Cozzens – Parliamentarian. I am so pleased that they are on the Board and know they will do a bang up job.


