JANUARY SPEAKER

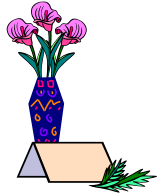
We are fortunate to have **Ernie Cowan** as our speaker this month. He will give a presentation on fishing the Sierras and the forthcoming trout season outlook.

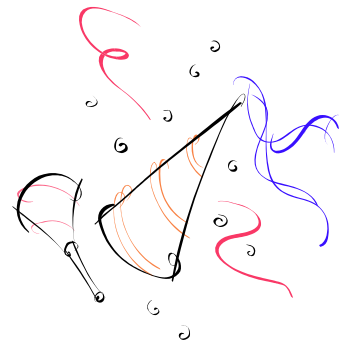

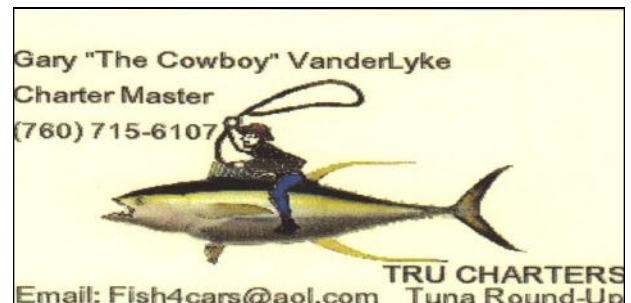
