The Bluefin and Yellowtail have been biting on overnight boats. **It's time to go fishing!!!**

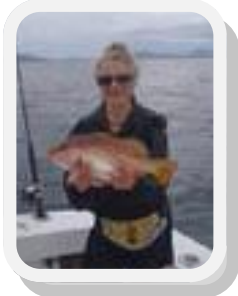
All the 11/2 day trips are full, but will take standbys.

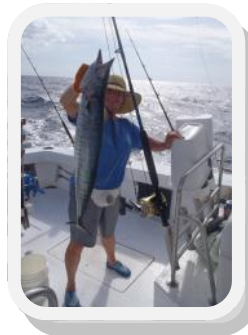
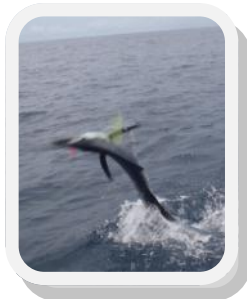
July 19 and August 16. Phone **Don Continelli** at (760)224-3458 for details.

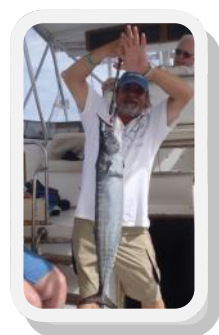

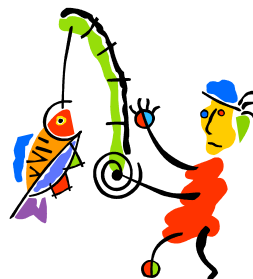

- Largest fish caught during the year for Class I – Salt Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II – Fresh Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II – Salt Water

Club Specie Record: Club Historian shall record all Specie Certificates. Specie Records will be posted on the Web Site. Members breaking old records need to submit proper evidence. They shall be recognized on a regular basis.
