ON-SHORE FISHING



The stairs consist of 3 flights of about 10 stairs with flat spots. I'm hoping the sand crabs will be plentiful and sometimes mussels can be excellent bait, too. You can always use plastic, blood worms, squid, or shrimp for bait.




