Our guest speaker on June 14th will be **Robert Hutsel**, Executive Director, San Diego River Park Foundation. Rob, as he likes to be called, will speak about the 52-mile long San Diego River Foundation's activities to improve the San Diego River for future fisheries and recreational activities.

Rob attended UC San Diego where he studied Urban Studies and Planning. He continues as a guest lecturer at UCSD, SDSU and several national and state conferences.

Rob was named the 2008 national River Hero for his leadership with the River Park Foundation, and his more than 20 years of volunteering in San Diego. In 2009, he was awarded the President's Award by San Diego State University's President and was recently at the White House to accept the National Take Pride in America Award on behalf of the Foundation's volunteer programs.

Join me as we look forward to hearing Rob tell us what the foundation with over 3,000 volunteers who provide in excess of 25,000 hours of service annually have accomplished within the San Diego River watershed.

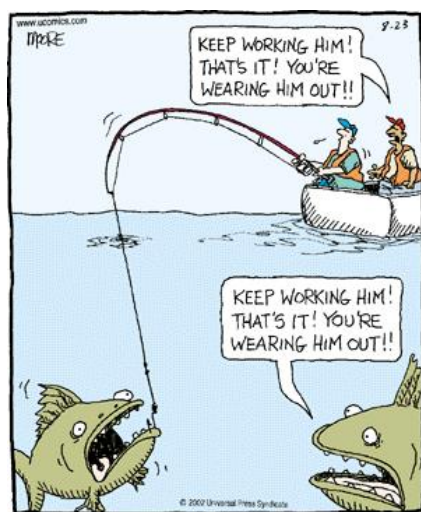

- Largest fish caught during the year for Class I – Salt Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II – Fresh Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II – Salt Water

Club Specie Record: Club Historian shall record all Specie Certificates. Specie Records will be posted on the Web Site. Members breaking old records need to submit proper evidence. They shall be recognized on a regular basis.
