

**Joanne Jauert** provided this dessert At the Pinezanita campout. It was so good and so many asked for the recipe so we thought we'd share it with all of you. YUMMY!

#### No Bake Pretzel, Peanut Butter, Chocolate Bars

In a large mixing bowl put:

1 ½ cups crushed pretzels (Joanne used stick pretzels)

1 ½ cups powdered sugar

1 cup peanut butter

1 stick butter, melted

Mix together well. Press the mixture into a 9 x 13 baking dish. Refrigerate.

**Topping** 

In a microwave safe bowl put:

1 1/2 cups semi-sweet chocolate chips

½ cup peanut butter

Microwave until smooth (30 to 45 seconds)

Stir the chocolate mixture until smooth, pour over the pretzel bar. Refrigerate. Cut the bars and cover in tight lidded container. Store in the refrigerator.
