A Line from your President....

The dim light at the end of the tunnel I referred to in my last letter continues to get brighter. The number of Covid cases has been dropping rapidly in the last month, and opportunities to get the vaccine are increasing as more vaccine stations are opening. For those of us in the North County there are now vaccine centers conveniently located nearby. They include Palomar Medical Center Downtown in Escondido, San Marcos Super Station at Cal State San Marcos, Linda Rhoades Rec. Center in Vista and North Coastal Live Well Center in Oceanside. In addition, many of you can get your vaccination from your insurance carrier.

If any of you are having trouble signing up for a vaccine, or don't have an email address or mobile phone, you can **c**all the CA COVID-19 Hotline at 1-833-422-4255 (M-F 8AM-8PM, Sa-Su 8AM-5PM) for assistance.

The more of us that get vaccinated, the closer we will come to being able to meet as a group again.

In addition, more diverse opportunities to get out and recreate are also becoming available as businesses and recreational facilities start to reopen. For those of you who enjoy camping, some private and public campgrounds have reopened, including State campgrounds, Santee Lakes and Lake Cuyamaca. Local fishing lakes have been actively stocking trout. Recent winds damaged docks at both Dixon Lake and Poway Lake and they remain closed to boating, but Lake Wohlford has finally reopened and is renting boats. Since last week's opening, an 11 lb. and two 9 lb. trout have been caught.

With cooler Winter water temperatures, saltwater fishing appears to be mainly focused on ½ day trips. According to the Fisherman's Landing website, "fishing charters are open and will be running all trips as scheduled. Our fleet is doing everything they can to ensure that we observe all safety protocols to provide the safest environment possible for your fishing trip."

They opened on February 13 with a plant of 3000 trout the Wednesday before. Then they stocked again on February 17 with 1500 trout. The next scheduled plant is 1500 trout on March 3. They are putting some nice size trout in the Lake. It looks like the City has killed some tules, hopefully creating more areas to fish in the future and cleaned up some of Senior Shore line. For now, they are not allowing any fishing on the docks, but they are renting boats out. Senior Day is Tuesday and Thursday with a discount on boat rentals. I know we haven't been meeting out there for our fishing challenges but I, along with Jim Davidson, have been enjoying the lake. Hope to see some of you out there."


