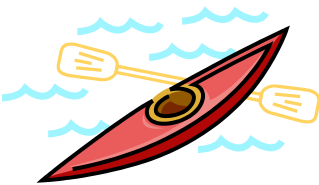
MAY SPEAKER

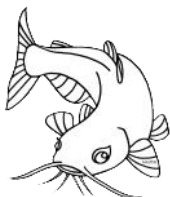

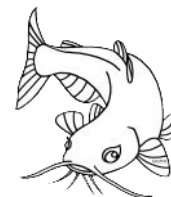
