Scientist to discuss Carlsbad seabass research facility

This month's program comes from recommendations by our own members after an enthusiastic endorsement of a presentation recently.

We have invited Mike Shane, marine biologist with the Hubbs-SeaWorld Research Institute in Carlsbad to speak on November 18.

One of the most valuable assets we have in San Diego County is the Hubbs-SeaWorld Research Institute. Built on land at the Agua Hedonia Lagoon in Carlsbad, this 22,000-square-foot hatchery has as its goal the restoration of the California white seabass population



through aquaculture and fish growth techniques developed at the Institute. The hatchery is capable of producing over 350,000 juvenile white seabass annually. They recently delivered 10,000 baby white seabass to a new, temporary home in San Diego Harbor.

Mike Shane is an expert in the growth of aquaculture fish in cages. He is doing extensive research in several areas including the study of the age and growth of wild and captive white seabass. The independent research facility has a vast program of education, outreach, and research designed to replenish the ocean resources.

This promises to be a very interesting and informative program.

The Senior Anglers of Escondido is open to the public and meets the third Friday of each month at the Joslyn Center in Escondido.





Club Species Record: Club Historian shall record all Species Certificates. Species Records will be posted on the Web Site.
