
Lake Cuyamaca-October `19th to 24th



Trout Derby Postponed

As of Thursday the 30th of October the water temperature of Lake Dixon is over 76 degrees. With the stocking date scheduled for November the 5th or 6th there is not enough time for the lakes water to drop to a safe level for trout to survive. So the city had no choice but to postpone the derby. The reschedule dates will be determined when the water is a healthy temperature for trout.

All the volunteers who signed up to help in the trout derby have been called and notified of the post-ponement of this years event. First of all I want to thank you for volunteering to help. When the city determines when the derby will be held, you will be notified and hopefully you'll still be able to help with the weighing and/or the Kiddy Pond. We appreciate your patience and cooperation and will let you know as soon as possible of the new dates. If you have planned on bringing any youngsters to the Kiddy Pond or informed anyone about this event, please let them know of this postponement. Thanks a bunch and you all have a great November. 
