



SURF FISHING

On September 29, fourteen SAE members and guests traveled north to Jalama Beach Campground in Northern Santa Barbara County to compete in the September Surf Fishing Tournament Competition.

After enduring the one-and-a-half-hour drive on a two-lane county road from 101 we discovered one of the most beautiful campgrounds on the California Coast.

Despite extremely heavy winds on the first two days we enjoyed four gorgeous sunny days with warm water and great fishing. We will return.

We caught and released nearly 50 barred perch, in the 3 to 8 ounce range, over the four days with **Frank Mancha** landing eighteen. **Linda Perdue** was the tournament winner with a 9 ounce perch.

All the fish were caught using live lug worms or plastic sand worms.
