

What's new in the Bait and Tackle field? To discover the answer, members of the Senior Anglers of Escondido have invited Pat Martin, owner of Pat's Bait and Tackle in Vista, to share his knowledge and experience with the club at the meeting on Friday, October 21.

Pat worked at the Hubbs-Sea World Research Institute marine fish hatchery in Carlsbad in the early years and later was an employee at several other bait and tackle shops in North

County. He contin-

ued to make connections with the industry and eventually opened his own shop in Vista. The shop has grown to a full line of impressive high-end freshwater plastics as well as popular baits for bass hunters such as the locally produced Mattlures swimbaits. He has a full array of trolling lures for everything from albacore to marlin, iron jigs, and a wide selection of bulk line that can be put on the reels while you wait.



But the best reason to visit Pat's Bait and Tackle is to talk to Pat himself. He is a well-rounded angler with a wealth

of knowledge from marlin fishing to fly-fishing. If not in the store, you can bet he is out on some kind of fishing trip.


The cost of the Turkey Fry is \$5 per person and must be in by October 24. Contact the Lages to find out what you need to bring.







