The Polaris Supreme had a wide open bite of bluefin tuna for almost 4 hours! I was on a 2 1/2 day boat with two day limits of yellowfin the first day. Bags full and overflowing. This is also happening on one day, overnight and 1 1/2 day boats!!!

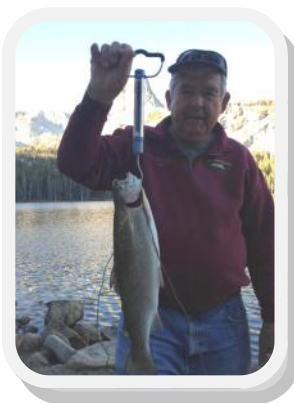

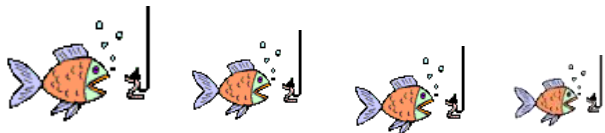
## PROGRAM

He graduated from Stanford University in 1965 and then spent four years as an officer in the US Air Force, where he was awarded a Bronze Star for time in Southeast Asia.

After returning to San Diego he earned a Captain's license to operate sport fishing passenger boats, and spent the next 12 years as a skipper and boat owner. During that time he owned and operated two 65-foot charter boats, both named CAT SPECIAL. He has also fished commercially for tuna and has commercially harpooned swordfish

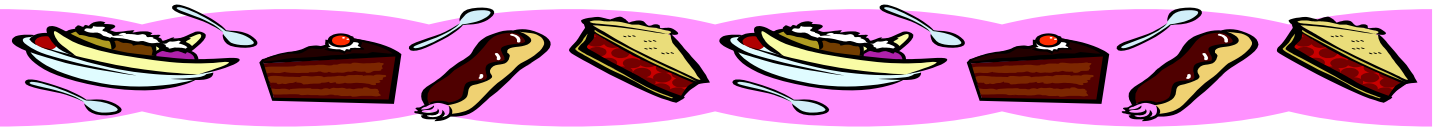

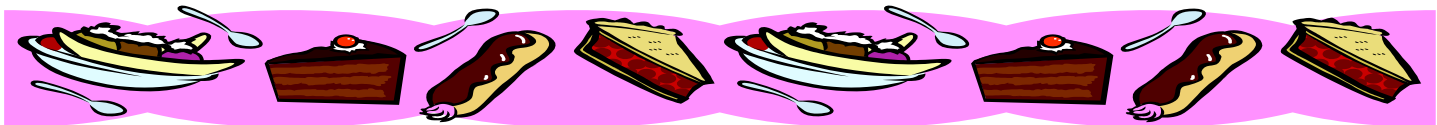

\$5 per person—must be in by the October Meeting

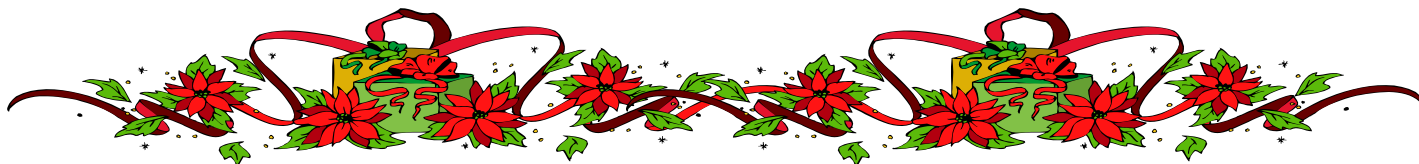

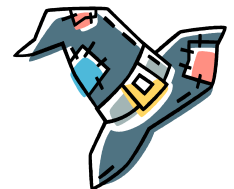
