SAE OUTLOOK

Our annual fish fry was held at Lake Dixon, one of the largest 'Fish Fry's', hosted by the Senior Anglers of Escondido. **Hank and Janet Skaja** organized the event. With plenty of fish, desserts, coleslaw and all the fixings. Plenty of good fish was provided by **Gary Vanderlyke, Jim Stevenson, Brenda McQueen and Barbara Gattuso**. **Hank Skaja** also provided some of his woodworking specialties for the opportunity drawing. These cutting boards were made in the shape of fish, pig and a wooden paddle. They were made from unique hardwoods. A special thanks to the **Skaja's** for going above and beyond for this event.

The speaker for the August general meeting was **Wayne Kotow**, the executive director of the Coastal Conservation Association. He updated the club regarding ongoing legislation that is currently attacking recreational fishing. He also provided information for the best way for the club to voice their concerns regarding future regulations.

Currently saltwater fishing is having a very good year. Half day boats are up to 70 yellowtail per day with a few Bonito and Kelp Bass. In addition to yellowtail the three-quarter day boats are catching some bluefin and Dorado. A 45.3 pound Dorado was caught last week. This is the largest Dorado reported this season.

SURF FISHING

The August Surf Fishing Event was very successful. Breakfast at the **Tip-Top Meat Market** was by far the best yet. **Hank Mabrey** caught a 15 oz. Leopard Shark, **Jeff Routsong** landed a nice 9oz. Yellowfin Croaker and **Don Continelli** caught a 7 oz. Corbina.

Landing a Croaker and Corbina is a significant change in the fishing from previous months. Sixteen anglers participated, including four fairly new members. So far 25 members have joined to tournament for a one time fee of \$10, with two more tournament dates left in the year to win the Bill Varney Signature Model 8' Cousins Surf Rod and reel – a \$280 value.
