FISH AND GAME REPRESENTATIVE TO DISCUSS CONSERVATION PROJECTS AND POSSIBLE BUDGET CUTS AT ESCONDIDO ANGLERS MEETING

Recent legislation and budget cuts have had a major impact on hunting, fishing, and wildlife conservation in Southern California and San Diego. With these issues in mind, the Senior Anglers of Escondido have invited Steve Wertz of the California Department of Fish and Game to inform and clarify new legislation and regulations and how they affect anglers and local citizens. Wertz is scheduled to speak at the Anglers meeting on Friday, September 16.

Wertz is connected with the Marine Region, which serves the entire California coastline from border to border, and three nautical miles out to sea. He plans to discuss new fishing regulations, policies, license procedures, conservation, and resources available to California anglers.

He also has been a member of the Master Plan Science Advisory Team for the Marine Life Protection Act (MPA) which will include marine parks offshore including La Jolla, Imperial Beach, Point Loma and other spots. The act is scheduled to take effect on October 1 of this year. Under the Marine Life Protection Act, the 49 MPAs and three special closures cover approximately 354 square miles of state water in Southern California and represents about 15 percent of the region.

The Senior Anglers of Escondido have many civic projects including taking an active role to preserve Palomar Mountain State park as recreation and fishing area for local residents. Members also organize several community projects including youth activities, fishing projects, and related civic efforts. The club is open to the public and meets the third Friday of each month at the Joslyn Center in Escondido. The program starts at 9:30 AM.








Class II – Same as Class I except trip is not Club Sponsored.

**Species - designate type of bass, trout catfish, salmon, tuna, etc.

For purposes of Club Records and Awards, following shall be recognized:

- Largest fish caught during year for Class I- Fresh Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class I Salt Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II Fresh Water
- Largest fish caught during the year for Class II Salt Water

Club Species Record: Club Historian shall record all Species Certificates. Species Records will be posted on the Web Site.

Members breaking old records need to submit proper evidence. They shall be recognized on a regular basis.
